Who can participate? Generally if you're 21 or older and have worked 1,000 hours, you can participate in the Administaff 401(k) Plan. Learn the right way to lift

When you lift, let your leg muscles do the work-not your back. To lift safely:

- Squat down next to the load, keeping your knees bent.
- Tighten your stomach muscles.
- Get a good grip.
- Bring the load close to your body.
- Lift slowly, without jerking.
- Walk with small steps, holding the load waist high and close to your body.
- Move your whole body to change direction-never twist!
- To lower the load, reverse the process.
