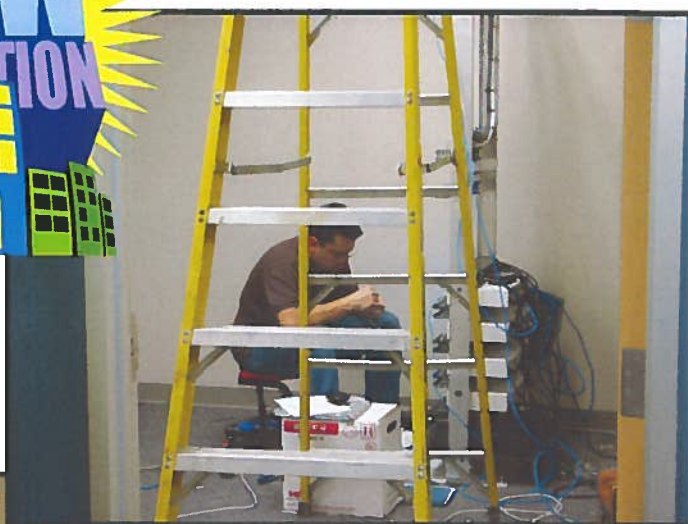

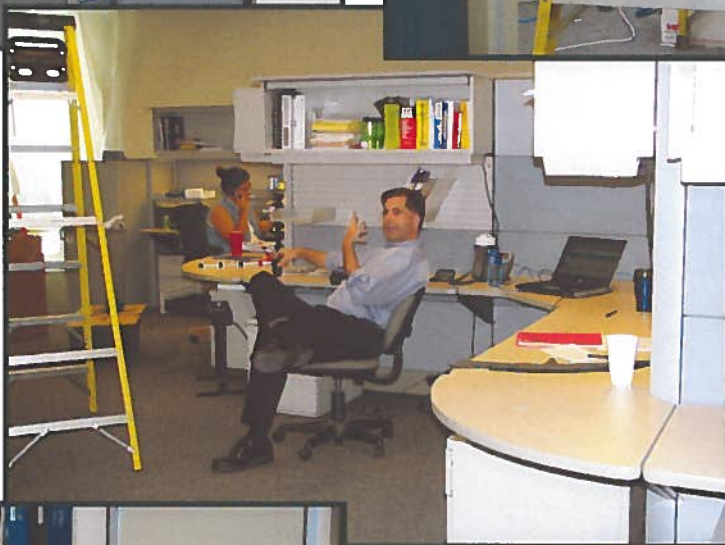

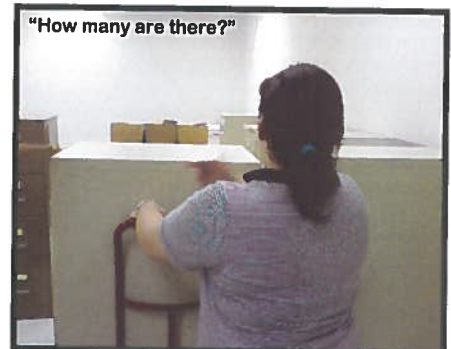
George Mihalcik – For the superb planning and execution of the move details...and having to constantly change the details because iRex couldn't make up their minds.

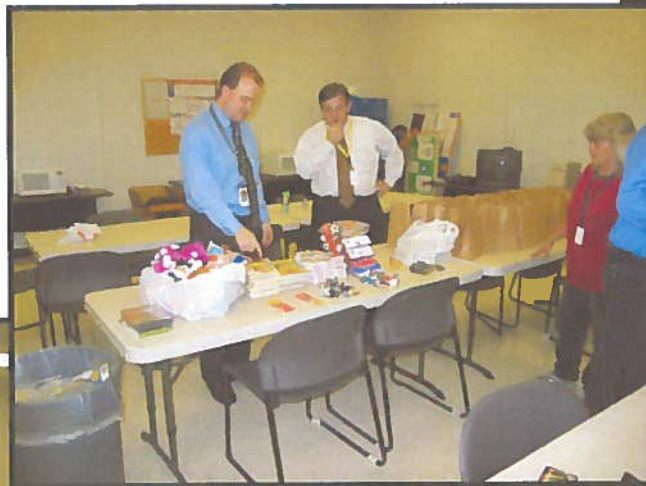
COMMUNITY CITIZENSHIP

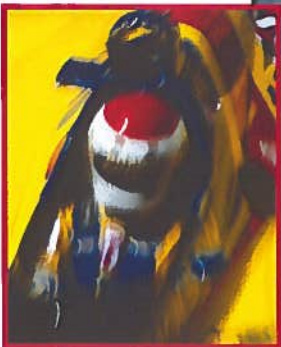
