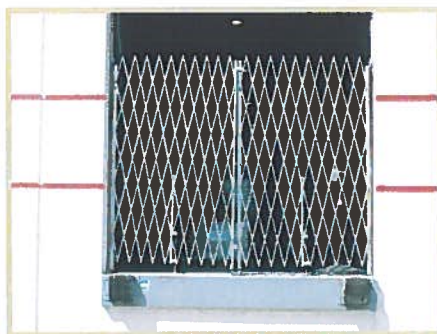

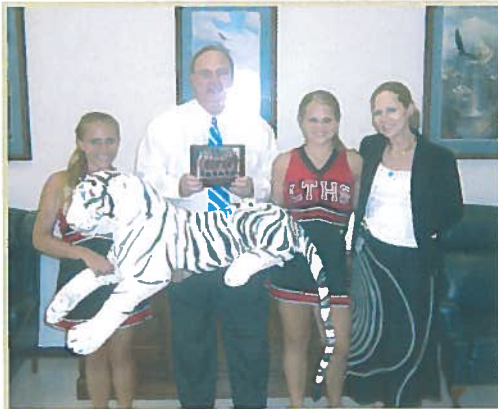
Cheerleader Sponsorship

"Dear iRex, Thank you for all the good things that the company does for us, such as having a clean facility and a bigger parking lot."

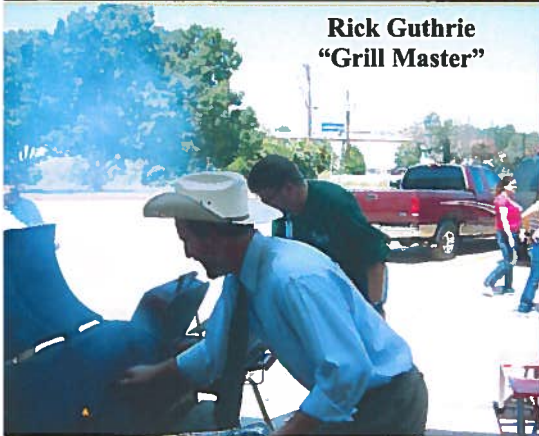
"What I like most is that the supervisors treat us so well. Everyone does a great job! It's nice to have a clean and nice facility."

"As always, I enjoy working with a lot of the employees here. This new place is very spacious making it easier to place and pull material from shelves."

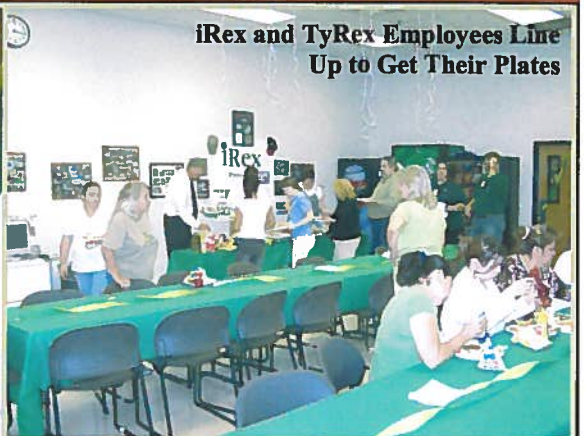

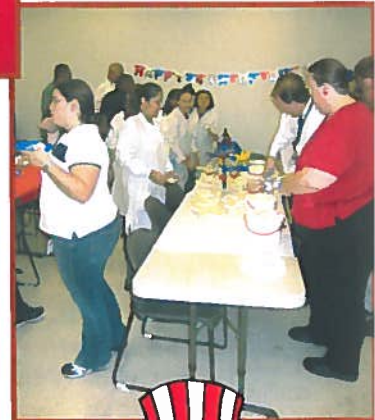

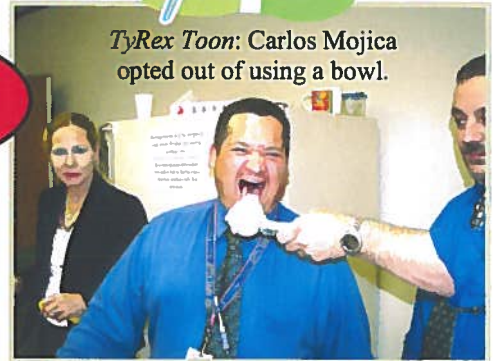
