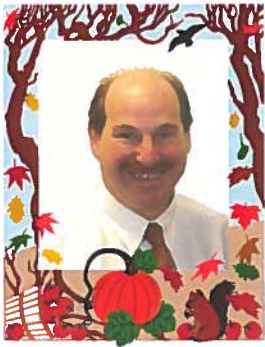

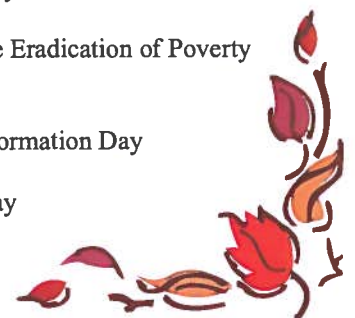

The clothes were delivered to Tarrytown United Methodist Church on Monday, July 31st.

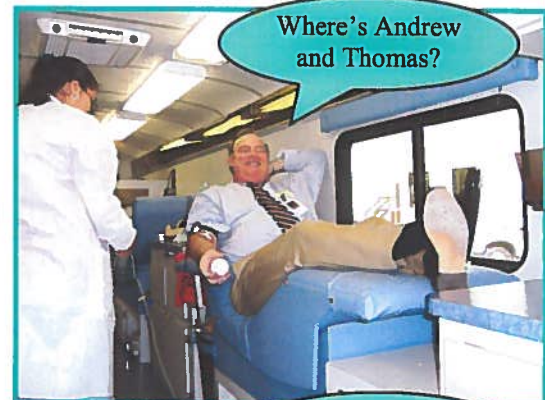
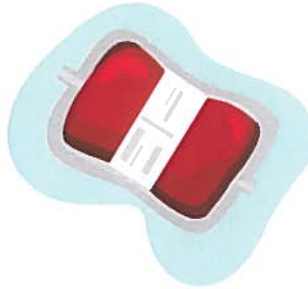

Dear Megladon,

Thank you for the timely turnaround on the repair of our fiber optic cable, which allowed us to stay in a tight schedule. We had an out of town crew of engineers and scientists onsite for the first underwater shake down cruise of NASA's Europe mission proof of concept vehicle, DepthX. Our link to the autonomous underwater vehicle for testing and development is a fiber optic cable. With an expensive, pressure rated bulkhead connector, the thin fiber is our only link to the submersible robot while it is underwater. During final hookup, it was discovered that it had been accidentally crushed by one of the heavy pressure housings. After contacting John Culbert and explaining the situation, he had me drive up with the damaged cable. After examining the damage and showing me where the break was by injecting light through the cable, he handed it off to April and Cynthia. The next day they had it repaired and ready to be put back in our system. It was much appreciated that with one call, and one day turn around, a potentially debilitating problem was resolved.

Thanks again John, to you and your team.
